Volunteers Help Clients

Our Client Services Manager can train you to assist clients with applying to AEF/BCEF for assistance, providing correct documentation, and receiving grants. No prior training in social work or customer services is necessary but we need a regular commitment of four hours per week during business hours at our offices.

Throughout the year, AEF and BCEF plan fundraising events like our Annual Awards Gala. Helping us meet these volunteer commitments at events is worth over \$100,000 per year to AEF/BCEF in grants from these groups.
